“DIGI-YOU-TH”

THIS TRAINING AIMS TO IMPROVE INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT) COMPETENCES OF YOUTH WORKERS NEEDED FOR SUCCESSFUL INITIATION, IMPLEMENTATION AND PROMOTION OF ACTIVITIES/PROJECTS OUTREACHING AND INVOLVING YOUNG PEOPLE USING DIGITAL TOOLS AND MEDIA.

TRAINING TOPICS (DRAFT):

Online learning part:

- Introduction and getting to know each other
- Basic terminology 1 - ICT, digital competences, online tools
- Basic terminology 2 - youth work, young people, youth activities
- Digital and online tools that we use and love

Residential training in Crnomelj:

- ICT and digital literacy - why is it important for youth workers and for young people?
- Youth work - what is so special?
- Digital and online tools that we use and love (continuation of the activity done online)
- Know your youth - what is our target group and how to approach it?
- Parallel sessions: gamification, online activism, online fundraising, managing groups online, online campaigning and advocacy, online learning basics
- How to choose tools and how to create content for young people?
- Practical work in groups on creating and presenting digital content for young people

PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

LODGING:

Participants will be accommodated in youth hostel in beautiful town of Crnomelj in Slovenia. Organisers will provide 3 meals and 2 coffee breaks per day. The selected participants will receive the detailed Info-Pack with more information about all practical issues of this training and other useful information.

TRAVEL:

- 100% of the total travel costs will be reimbursed ONLY for the cheapest way of transport (according to the maximum travel costs table which you can find in attachment);
- Travel costs will be reimbursed by bank transfer to ORGANIZATION'S bank account, AFTER participant provide us with ALL ORIGINAL TICKETS and required documents;
- Travel plan MUST be previously approved by organizers;
- Participants must keep all travel documents (tickets, bills, travel agency invoices and boarding passes), as organizers are able to make reimbursement only on the bases of presented documents.

You will have support from organizers and your sending organization to reach the venue and also do the administrative tasks regarding reimbursement.

HOW TO APPLY

We invite participants to apply for this training and fill out the online [APPLICATION FORM](#) and submit it until **05th of November 2018 with prior consultation and pre-selection by their sending organizations.**

ONLY COMPLETED registration forms will be admitted. Registration forms sent after the deadline will NOT be accepted and as the organizers, we have right to search for another participant. Also, in the case that chosen participant cancel their presence on the Training, the sending organization is required to replace them as soon as possible with another participant of their NGO.

NOTE: This training course is 1 module of the whole learning programme composed of these elements:

- 1. ONLINE LEARNING PART**
- 2. RESIDENTIAL TRAINING**
- 3. FOLLOW UP PRACTICE (SUPPORTED BY MENTORSHIP).**

Participants are required to participate in all three parts of the module.
